On 15-16 March, ARCC Staff delegates Faisal and Gatluak visited Christchurch eight of the mosque attack survivors' and victims' families. They delivered a culturally appropriate message of sympathy and solidarity, shared meals, and provided a donation. The donation had been collected by ARCC online Stripe account as part of our contribution toward victims' families from the NZ public. The families were very receptive to the visit and stated that it was the first time someone came to hear what they had been through face-to-face and give valuable support. The delegates listened to harrowing accounts from some of the survivors of the attack and visited the graves of some of the victims.

There, they learned about Te Tiriti o Waitangi (The Treaty of Waitangi) and Rangiriri Pā, an old Māori settlement that was attacked by British Troops in 1863. They received a very educational experience from the perspective of the Māori at the time. Francois Kayembe, from the Okapi Alliance of New Zealand (Congoese community from the Democratic Republic of Congo), observed that it was a “very touching, but traumatic, learning experience.”

LAUNCH OF ITI REAREA COLLECTIVE

The microfinance collaboration Iti Rearea Collective officially launched on 17 April. The collective provides programmes to help migrants develop their own businesses or improve businesses they already own. Iti Rearea has seen promising results in the first five weeks of its programme so far, with a cohort of 26 people and is getting ready for its second intake.
