RESETT TV TALK

Episode 10 of ARCC Resett TV Talk highlights on one of the ARCC projects called New Resident Magazine. The New Resident Magazine aims to provide a voice for new residents and resettled migrants who arrived at New Zealand under the Refugee Quota Programme and Family Reunification category. It recognizes those who have navigated positive education and employment pathways over the years, to highlight potential avenues to successful settlement. For the episode 10, we invited the special guests whose success stories were featured in our New Resident Magazine Vol.2, Fazal ur Rehman Shoukat, who is originally from Karachi, Pakistan, working as a Picker and Packer at Repco GPC in Auckland and Yousif Faisal Farghaly, a thriving youth from South Sudanese community, who is pursuing Mechatronics Engineering at Massey University. They shared their journey to New Zealand and their experiences and challenges faced when they resettled in a new country.

Resett TV Talk Episode 11 was aired on the 25th March. In this episode, we reflected on the work of ARCC and shared 3 workstreams of ARCC which are Community wellbeing, Advocacy for change and ARCC growth and development. We reflected on the programmes, projects and community support services delivered by ARCC based on those workstreams. Moreover, we want to make sure that our NZ public is well-informed with the right information to avoid disinformation and misinterpretation about New Zealand resettlement process. We aimed to advocate and educate the forced-migrant communities to understand their rights and entitlements within the New Zealand context as new residents and citizens of this country.

The summary of the Needs Assessment survey that was conducted at the end of 2022 was presented to Community Leaders. We also updated members about ARCC's activities.





This is a 12-week programme with 3-hour group workshops on Saturdays (2-5pm) in a class where participants will be able to refine a business idea, learn about marketing strategies, put a financial and business plan together, and learn about access to a microfinance loan to start their business. Our upcoming cohort will start on the 29th of April 2023 and places are filling fast.
