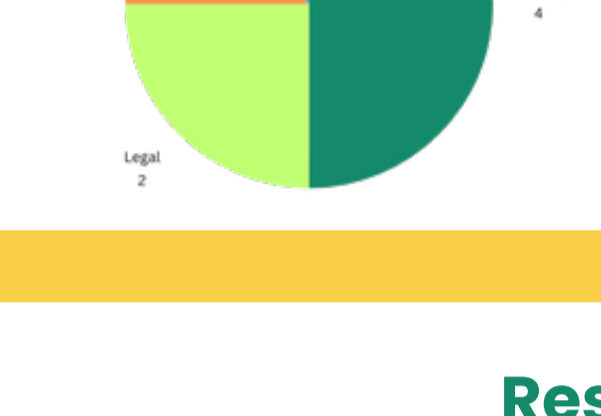


Women Leadership Network (WLN)

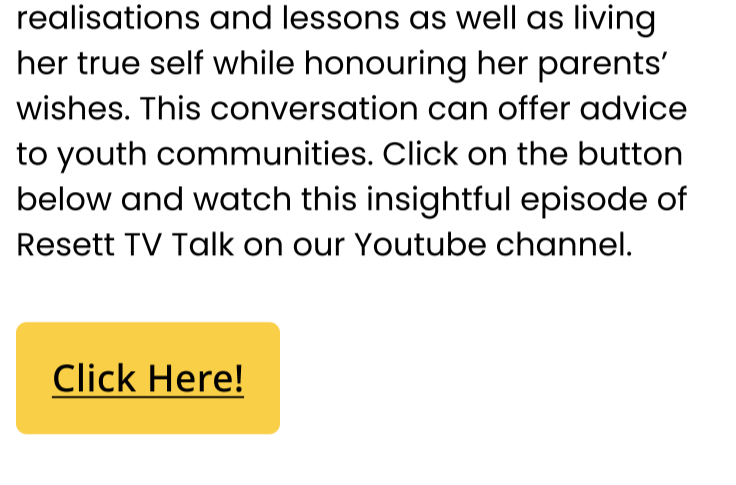


February Community Cases

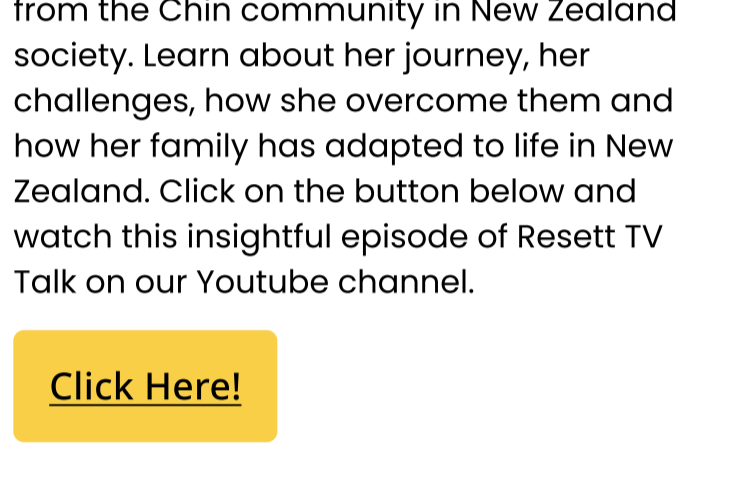

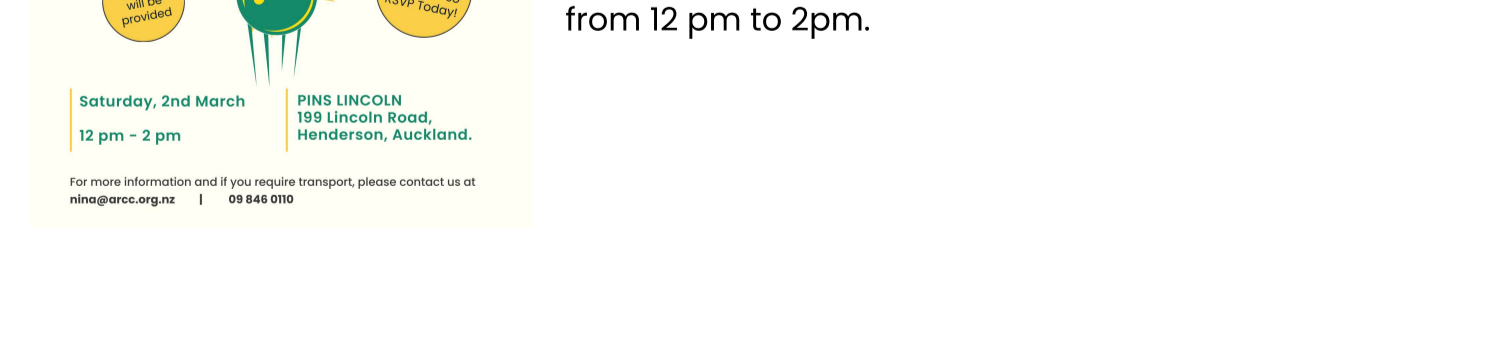
MAT- Online English Classes for Migrants

Pre Ramadan Night Bazaar

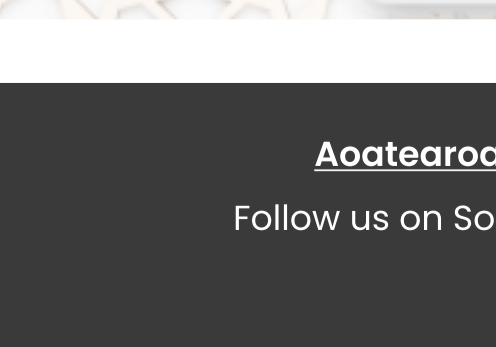

Auckland Council Long Term Plan 2024-2034

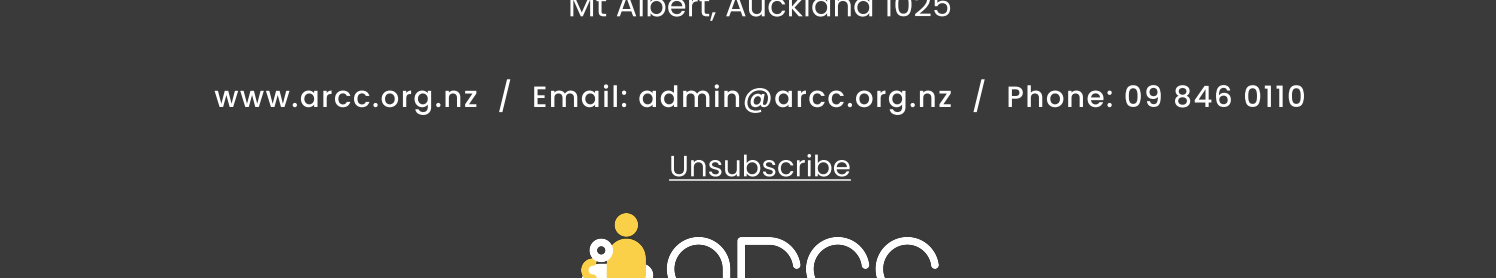
